

2026 ASC TOURNAMENT RULES

Please retain these rules and adhere accordingly

1. **PARTICIPANTS:** The **2026 Atlanta Senior's Classic Tournament** will be hosted by Bowlero Austell. All participants must be 55 years of age at time of bowling and must be USBC certified.
2. **ENTRY FEE:** **TEAM EVENT - \$40 per person; DOUBLES EVENT - \$40 per person** (\$22.00 prize fund-\$18.00 lineage and expenses). **OPTIONAL SINGLES - \$20** – scores will be derived from DOUBLES event. **Total payment for a full team bowling TEAM and DOUBLES - \$80.** Ratio 1:8. Prize fund will be returned 100%. Scratch winners will be paid 10% of total prize money in Team and Doubles. Scratch Ratio 1:15. In case of a tie for 1st place in any event, co-champions will be declared and 1st place money shall be combined and divided equally among the teams/individuals posting a tie. **NO PERSONAL CHECKS: BANK CHECK OR ZELLE only.**
3. **RE-ENTRIES:** Multiple participation is permitted in each event, but you can cash only once with the same partner. Highest score will take precedence.
4. Any bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any tournament within the previous 12 months must report their actual score, position, and amount won to tournament director prior to bowling for possible re-rating. If bowler has been rerated within the last 12 months, that rerated average must be reported before bowling or bowler is subject to disqualification. Average adjustments can be made up to 24 hours after completion of bowling. Failure to comply with these provisions shall be cause for forfeiture of entry fee and prize winnings. A bowler is subject to being rerated by tournament manager based on their past performance in this tournament. If a bowler is rerated, the bowler has the option to request a refund prior to bowling. Tournament Manager reserves the right to reject any entry and return any entry fees. **Rule 319 will apply**
5. **AVERAGE:** Bowlers will use (1) **USBC 2025-2026 composite average; (2) bowler can present a 2026 sanctioned league standing sheet as of May 1, 2026. All others will bowl scratch.** Bowlers are responsible for verifying their averages, whether submitted by bowler or the team captain. **HANDICAP: 90% OF 220.** The 10-Pin Rule does not apply.
6. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency cause relating thereto or there from or any reason beyond the control of the Atlanta Seniors' Classic Tournament shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled up to the time of such termination.
7. **USBC RULES** shall govern any rules not covered herein.
